- Teachers are responsible for the whereabouts of their students during the lunch breaks.

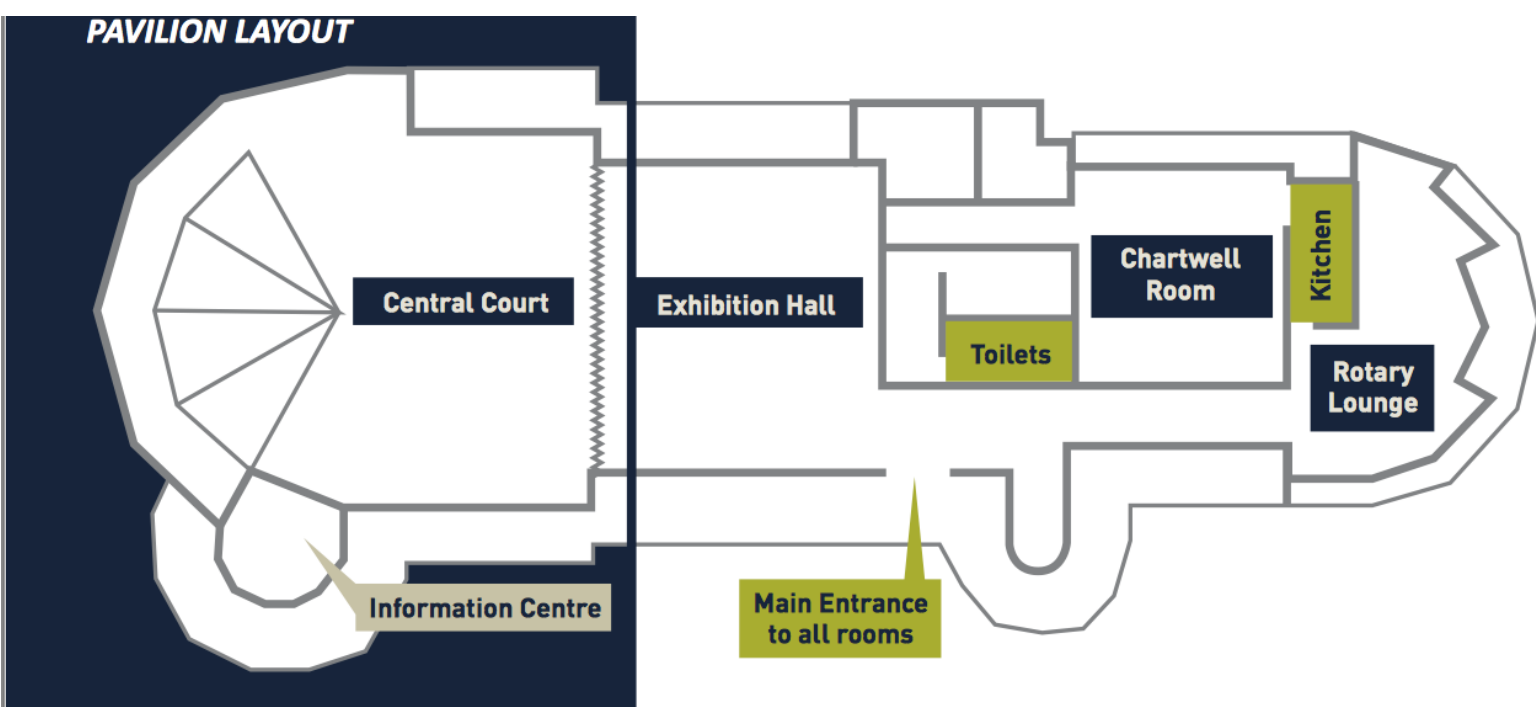
How to get there:

Science Spinners Creative Lab will be run from the Hamilton Gardens Pavilion, Hungerford Cres, SH1 Cobham Drive, Hamilton
Hamilton Gardens is well sign posted.

From SH1 North Stay on SH1 through Hamilton until you reach Cobham Drive. At the roundabout turn right into GATE 1.

From SH1 South: Stay on SH1 until you reach Cobham Drive, then take your first left at the roundabout into GATE 1.

Car Parking: Car parking is available in the main car park through Hungerford Cres.





Rules around the venue:

Hamilton Gardens is a public venue and if the weather is fine you can expect many patrons to be enjoying the surrounding areas and gardens. Please note the Pavilion toilets are also open to the public.

Please ensure the students in your care throughout the day remain on their best behaviour when taking part in our event and that you are aware of their whereabouts throughout the day.

Dress: Students should wear school uniform. They can bring their school bags, but is not necessary unless they are carrying items they need. These can be kept in the Chartwell room as there will be a staff member in there most of the day. No valuables should be left unattended as this is also a public place.

Meals: Lunch is provided, but students may bring their own snacks and water bottles. Tea/coffee will be available for teachers in the Chartwell room.
